Masters categories will be raced as a single event using the "Head Handicap System" Crews may be divided into bands for medals, determined by Ranking Points and age categories. Bands will be declared on the draw.

Entering the same crew in the same boat type is permitted in the relevant divisions. No out of division crews will be permitted.

Doubling up is permitted, but one of the entries may be rejected to maximise racing opportunities for competitors. Events with less than 3 entries may also be rejected.
